


# Sunderland Quakers: Conditions for Holding In Person Meeting for Worship

### **PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND THE MEETING IF YOU FEEL ILL FOR ANY REASON**

People who remain vulnerable should still take extra precautions to reduce risk of exposure. Everyone should respect the needs of everyone else to enable their accommodation and inclusion and for everyone to feel as safe as possible.

**1)** Back on the Map, Carnegie Community Corner has its own measures and procedures in place in regard to Covid. These include, twice weekly “fogging” of the building and a one-way entrance and exit system.

**2)** *There will be at least two people from Sunderland Quakers responsible for opening and closing the building. They will also act as stewards for the Meeting. Please respond positively to their requests and instructions.*

**3)** Please do not use the main entrance on the corner to access the building. Enter the building via the pathway from Toward Road around the rear of the building.

**4)** *Please note the entrance goes straight into the space we are using and there may already be people in Worship. Please approach the entrance quietly.*

**5)** We ask that people remain acceptably distanced at all times. Everyone should respect people's personal space at all times.

**6)** *We require everyone (unless medically exempt) to wear a face covering upon entering the building and to keep your covering on throughout.*

**7)** Upon entering please use the hand sanitiser provided which should be on your left.

**8)** *The building has its own specific QR code to scan for the purposes of Test and Trace.*

**9)** Please take a seat as soon as you can. They will be arranged in the space as soon as you enter. There may be people already seated in silence.

**10)** *Only use the seats provided. Please do not move them or use other seating. You may wish to bring your own cushion.*

**11)** The Meeting lasts for an hour. During this time people may speak or Minister as they are moved to do so. If needed face coverings may be removed whilst ministering but must be replaced when finished.

**12)** *The end of the Meeting will be signalled by those appointed to do so. This may be in the form of a few words, replacing our usual handshakes.*

**13)** At the end of the Meeting there is a short time to chat with others. Please remember to keep your face coverings on and maintain acceptable distances.

**14)** Exit the building via the main front doors maintaining distance from people as you leave.

**15)** *The room we are meeting in has a maximum capacity of 35 people with spacing. Should this capacity be reached, we will not be able to admit more people.*

**16)** The room has a high ceiling and is spacious. Windows and if appropriate doors will be open to increase ventilation.

**17)** *Please avoid touching surfaces if possible. Those stewarding will be responsible for switching on lights, opening doors etc.*
